1 - declares that he/she has carefully read and understood all the rules of the event called "Ledro Sky - Senter dele Greste", which he/she accepts in full and without reservation.

2 - declares that he/she is fully aware of all the characteristics and specific details of the race, of the trail and of the difficulties of the route, which shall take place in the mountains with potentially difficult weather conditions (such as, by way of example and not limited to, cold temperatures, wind, rain, snow, poor visibility, with temperatures that may vary from -5° to $+40^{\circ}$, etc.) and that he/she is aware of the personal safety risks associated with the competition.

3 - declares that he/she is an expert in mountain running races/trail running/skyrunning and that he/she is aware that taking part in the "Ledro Sky - Senter dele Greste" requires specific training and a real capacity for personal autonomy of which he/she declares to be in possession.

4 - declares that he/she has a medical certificate (a copy of which he/she shall provide) attesting that he/she is fit to take part in competitive sports with a high level of cardiovascular demand and is in good health and that he/she exonerates the organisers from any responsibility relating to and resulting from checking the aforementioned suitability.

5 - undertakes to bring the compulsory materials expressly indicated in the race rules with them throughout the duration of the competition and exonerates the organisers in case of accidents or illness or any damage attributable to the lack of said materials; he/she accepts that these compulsory materials may be inspected at any time during the race. He/she declares that he/she is aware that even if only one of the compulsory materials is missing during the race, then this may lead to them being disqualified and accepts the indisputable judgement of the individuals in charge of the inspection.

6 - undertakes to behave in accordance with the principles of fairness and sporting correctness and not to behave against the law and the rules, which may otherwise endanger their own safety or the safety of others, and to behave in an environmentally friendly manner. 7 - the athlete, aware of the responsibility involved with making false statements, hereby acknowledges and confirms that he/she has personally taken note of the race route and that he/she believes - as far as they are able to do so - that it is fully in line with his/her technical level; he/she is well aware that the aforementioned route has very challenging and difficult stretches despite being assisted by staff from the organisation; he/she has experience of skyrunning that is appropriate for the competition to which he/she is registering, having also recently taken part in similar events and nonetheless boasting experience in the mountains that is suitable for facing the aforementioned route; he/she has been thoroughly informed by the organisers of the potential dangers of the event, which takes place in a mountain environment and therefore entails unavoidable objective dangers for all competitors and that he/she, being fully aware of this, intends to take the risk anyway; he/she expressly exonerates the organisers from any liability for minor negligence (and within the limits of the law) in relation to any injury which the athlete himself/herself may suffer; he/she also exonerates the organisers shall not be responsibility related to theft and/or damage to any of his/her personal belongings, as he/she is aware that the organisers shall not be responsible for looking after them in any way, and from any liability for any damage caused by him/her to third parties and/or property owned by third parties.
